- First hour: Generic safety education: Roles, responsibilities, hazards, prevention, and all principles workers are required to know to complete their Ministry of Labour certification.
- Second hour: On-line work for participants to complete their mandatory Ministry of Labour Worker Awareness Certificates. This training and certification is required under the Occupational Health and Safety Act for every worker in Ontario
